Applications are hereby invited from students currently at tertiary institutions and, learners who already have passed Grade 12, for financial support for further studies in 2019 academic year. The award is limited to full-time studies at an accredited tertiary institution. Students must reside within the greater Kannaland Municipality including the rural areas.

The aim of the programme is to develop students and learners with potential within the Municipality's jurisdiction, directed partially to individuals from historically disadvantaged societal groups and individuals with disabilities.

Bursaries will be allocated for a period of three (3) years to allow students to undertake a full time Graduate Degree or Diploma in the following study fields namely, Finance, Economic, Accounting, Supply Chain Management, Internal Audit, Risk Management and Infrastructure.

Applications will only be considered if it is correctly completed and the following documentation is attached:

- Certified copy of Grade 12 certificate / Statement of results
- Proof of registration at any tertiary institution
- Certified copy of identity document
- Proof of residential address
