



KENNISGEWING - 26/2023

WATER BEPERKINGS - LADISMITH

Kennis geskied hiermee ingevolge die bepalings van Klousule 13 (5) van die Water verordeninge, gedateer 20 Junie 2003 dat die Raad van Kannaland vanweë 'n watertekort verplig is om 'n waterbeperking in te stel met **ONMIDDELIKE EFFEK TOT VERDERE KENNISGEWING.**

1. Die besproeiing van sportvelde, gholfbane, rolbalbane ens. is verbode.
2. Die was van voertuie, behalwe deur 'n kommersiële instandhouding wie se besigheid dit is om karre te was, is verbode. Kommersiele instandhouding moet drukspuite gebruik.
3. Die skoonmaak van enige area met water is verbode.
4. Waar eie water vanaf 'n boorgat of reservoir gebruik word moet 'n kennisbord "EIE WATER" op die perseel aangebring word. Die munisipaliteit behou die reg om inspeksie te doen waar "EIE WATER" aangedui word.
5. Die volmaak van privaat swembaddens is verbode..
6. Huishoudings moet hulle verbruik beperk tot 20kl/maand.
7. Industrieë moet hulle verbruik met 20% van hulle gemiddelde gebruik oor die afgelope 6 maande, verminder.
8. Tuine mag net per gieter of emmer tussen 18h00 en 19h00 op 'n Donderdag natgemaak word.
9. Die munisipaliteit sal van tyd tot tyd watertoevoer na sekere gebiede staak om die watervlakke in die reservoirs te balanseer.

Ten einde watervoorsiening aan die verbruiker te verseker te alle tye, het die Raad geen keuse om water beperking toestelle te installeer waar hushoudings en/of besighede die ooreengekome verbruik oorskry.

WATER RESTRICTIONS - LADISMITH

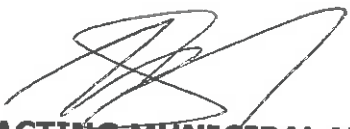
Notice is hereby given in terms of the regulations of Clause 13 (5) of the Water By-laws, dated 20 June 2003 that, due to a water shortage, the Council of Kannaland is compelled to institute restriction with **IMMEDIATE EFFECT UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.**

1. The irrigation of sports fields, golf course, bowling green exc. is prohibited.
2. Washing vehicles, except by a commercial maintenance, whose business it is to wash cars, is prohibited. Commercial maintenance must use a high pressure hose.
3. The cleaning of any area with water is prohibited.
4. Where own water from a borehole or reservoir is used a notice board "OWN WATER" on the premises must be displayed. The municipality reserves the right to inspect properties where "OWN WATER" is indicated.
5. The filling of private swimming pools is prohibited.
6. Household consumption is limited to 20kl/per month.
7. Industries must reduce their consumption with 20% of their average consumption over the past 6 months.
8. Gardens may only be watered by a watering can or bucket between 18h00 and 19h00 on Thursdays.
9. The municipality will interrupt the water supply to certain areas to balance the levels in the reservoirs.

To ensure water supply to the consumer at all-time the Council has no choice but to install water restriction devices to households and/or businesses where the agreed usage is exceeded.
