Other impermissible rates

In terms of Section 17(1) (i) of the MPRA, the Municipality may not levy a rate on improved property registered in the name of and used primarily as a place of public worship by a religious community, including an official residence registered in the name of that community which is occupied by an office bearer of that community who officiates at services at that place of worship.

Section 17 (1) (e) of the Act precludes Council from levying rates on those parts of a special nature reserve, national park or nature reserve within the meaning of the National Environmental Management: Protected Areas Act, 2003 (Act 57 of 2003), or of a national botanical garden within the meaning of the National Environmental: Management: Biodiversity Act, 2004 (Act 10 of 2004) which are not developed or used for commercial, farming or residential purposes. The apportioned value of any portion of such properties utilized for any purpose other than that used for such conservation purposes will be rated accordingly.

3. The Energy Regulator further directs as follows:

- 3.1 The municipality is required to submit a Report accounting for all costs that have been noted in relation to its COS study, to enable the Regulator to perform its independent verification by 30 September 2025;
 - 3.2 All cost information submitted by the municipality will be subject to an independent audit and may be clawed back upon receipt and verification of audited financial figures by the Regulator, by 30 September 2025;
 - 3.3 The municipality is further required to submit an audited Financial Report that reflects the impact of its Cost of Supply-based tariffs on customers, as well as on the licensee's sustainability and the local economy by 30 September 2025; and
 - 3.4 The Municipality must submit to NERSA a Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Realistic, and Time-bound (SMART) energy loss reduction plan aimed at reducing energy losses to single-digit levels. An appropriate budget must be allocated and utilised to support the implementation of this plan. Progress on both the plan and its associated budget must be monitored quarterly and reported to NERSA on a bi-annual basis, commencing 30 September 2025.
4. Please note that in terms of the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004), National Energy Regulator is entrusted to perform all the functions that the National Electricity Regulator used to perform, and amongst others, to review and approve tariff increase proposals by all licensed distributors of electricity in South Africa. Implementation of tariffs

without approval of the Energy Regulator is a contravention of the license conditions issued to you.

5. It is therefore important that provision is made in your planning / budgeting cycle to allow time for the submission of applications for future changes or increases to NERSA for consideration. In this regard, NERSA further requests the submission of your budgetary timelines to inform and align with our regulatory planning processes.
