In addition, to inculcate a culture of responsible conduct, self-discipline, high moral values, personal confidence and national pride among young people residing in rural areas.

All youth, male and female of all races and those living with disabilities currently residing in rural communities are invited to apply to participate in this 2 year programme.



SUCCESSFUL APPLICANT

Successful applicant will be required to be away from home for a period of about +-15 weeks attending National Youth Leadership Development Programme (NYLDP) and again be away from home for a period of about 24 months attending Skills Development Training at the TVET College to acquire SAQA accredited qualification. This period includes theoretical training at the College and work place (practical) training.

The programme focuses on community development and the successful participants will be required to perform community service during the NYLDP.

REQUIREMENTS: Applicants must be:

- Grade 12, Code B driving licence (Manual transmission),
- Must be medically, physically and mentally fit, Mathematical Literacy. No criminal record, 18 to 34 years of age.
- Unemployed and currently not enrolled with any other institution of higher learning.
- From poor household & Residing in Kannaland Municipal ity. Registered with SARS (provide proof).
- Prepared to study outside Western Cape for a long duration.
- Interested in studying Law Enforcement with
- NO criminal record
- Attach an advertisement in your application to indicate the opportunity you are applying for.
