WHAT IS NARYSEC?

NARYSEC stands for National Rural Youth Service Corps (NARYSEC) whose aim is to enhance skills development by providing unemployed rural youth with opportunities to work in their communities and to be trained to provide the necessary services for local socioeconomic development.

It is a long term programme of government facilitated, coordinated and implemented by the DALRRD in partnership with other national, provincial and local structures. Its intention is to ensure maximum value is derived from the skills and knowledge systems of rural populations. In the end, the enhancement of skills, the development of complete transferable competencies will improve the economic condition of rural areas and young people in particular.

NARYSEC puts emphasis on Community Service, Skills Development and Enterprise Development. Over time, NARYSEC seeks to achieve the goal of creating enterprises in the rural settings that are self-managed and sustainable. In addition, to inculcate a culture of responsible conduct, self-discipline, high moral values, personal confidence and national pride among young people residing in rural areas.

All youth, male and female of all races and those living with disabilities currently residing in rural communities are invited to apply to participate in this **2 year programme**.

SUCCESSFUL APPLICANT

Successful applicant will be required to be away from home for a period of about 4 months attending National Youth Leadership Development Programme (NYLDP) and again be away from home for a period of about 12 months attending Skills Development Training at the TVET College to acquire SAQA accredited qualification. This period includes theoretical training at the College for 6 months and work place (practical) training for 6 months.

The programme focuses on community development and the successful participants will be required to perform community service during the NYLDP.

REQUIREMENTS: Applicants must be:

- Between 18 and 35 years of age
- In possession Grade 12
- Unemployed and currently not enrolled with any other institution of higher learning.
- From poor household
- Registered with SARS (provide proof)
- Residing in Phillippi & Ottery
- Interested in studying Plant Production
- With NO criminal record

It should be noted that each applicant as a pre-condition for shortlisting should attach the following (Certified copy of ID, Proof of address Certified copy of grade 12 certificate/Statement, CV) as part of the application form.
