Telephone, electronic or e-mailed bids will not be accepted and the fully completed tender document must be submitted on the original document and remain valid for 90 days after the closing date of the tender. The municipality reserves the right to withdraw any invitation to tender and/or re-advertise or to reject any formal tender or to accept a part of it. The Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest or award a contract to the bidder scoring the highest number of points. Potential bidders should note that all projects in terms of this tender may not materialise.

A set of fully completed tender documents must be submitted on the original documents and remain valid for 90 days after the closing date of the tender. A set of tender documents can be obtained at a non-refundable cost of R427,35 including VAT. Tender documents will only be available at the compulsory classification meeting after providing proof of payment of the deposit. Documents must be booked with Mr E van Rooyen at SCM at 028 551 8000 two days before the classification meeting. NO BOOKING NO DOCUMENT.

Local Content Requirements: Electrical and telecom cables = 90%; Valves and actuators = 70%; Pumps, Medium Voltage Motors and Associated Accessories = 70%; Steel pipe fittings and specials = 80%.

The exchange rate used to calculate local production and content must be the exchange rate published by the South African Reserve Bank (SARB) on the date of the classification meeting.

A functionality evaluation will be done and bidders scoring less than the specified threshold (65/86) will be considered as non-responsive and will not be evaluated any further for pricing and preference.

The tender will be evaluated and adjudicated in terms of the 80/20 Preference Point System prescribed by the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (Act 5 of 2007) and the Municipality's Supply Chain Management Policy.
