A clarification meeting was held on 26 March 2019 at 10:00 in the Ladismith Library Hall. The discussions and questions raised are listed and we now provide answers as agreed upon, as follows:

1. Will a panel of engineers be appointed on different categories?	<i>Yes, a panel will be appointed on different categories depending on offers of responsive tenderers.</i>
2. On pg.62, C2.2 item 1.4 Explain what the unit is, is it hours or days?	<i>The time-based fees are allowable hours at certain rates per day, it should be read as no more than 2 hours per day claimable for professional engineers and no more than 4 hours per day for Technologists but Technicians and Technical staff may claim the full 8 hours per day. Each project is negotiated according to complexity.</i>

3. Should tenderers put in an offer for each category?	<i>No, just on the categories where enough expertise is owned.</i>
4. On pg.15 - Nature and extent of work, item 6 what is meant by the Other?	<i>Tenderer can specify the subcontractors, which are not listed, under item 6: Other.</i>
5. On pg.46 – Table Form of Offer, not every category is there.	<i>The table on page 46 will be amended to specify the categories. Electrical and Mechanical will be split into separate items in the tender.</i>
6. On pg.63-65: Is there a limit on the percentage offered?	<i>Maximum percentage discount offer is 10%. Ad-hoc projects on page 64 (2.1.8) will be removed from tender document as each project can already fit under its specific discipline.</i>
7. Is there a multi-year project plan available?	<i>The multi-year project plan will be available to the successful tenderers and in fact in the public domain and is reviewed yearly.</i>
8. How will the municipality determine order of appointments if prices are the same?	<i>Prices will be fixed as per tender offer inclusive of points scored for Price and additional points scored for Preferences and appointment will be according to the order of total points received.</i>
9. On pg.66 - Recoverable costs as generic price schedule?	<i>It's not generic, each tenderer should fill in their distance and time to travel from office to Ladismith under 3.1 (meetings). With regards to 3.2 (construction monitoring) this list has been expanded to depict each town in Kannaland and must be completed in full for each nearest town.</i>
10. On pg.67 Summary	<i>Section 2 will be expanded per category.</i>
11. On pg.17 - Can references be submitted 2-3 weeks after closing date and can the references be in any format?	<i>References can be submitted two weeks after closing date of tender, which will be 22 April 2019 no later than 12:00. References can be in any format as long as all the information that are requested in the tender document are submitted.</i>
12. Should references be submitted per category?	<i>Yes, references should be submitted per category.</i>
13. Will municipality consider to change the closing date of the tender?	<i>No, the closing date will remain 08 April 2019 at 12:00.</i>
